A. 2026 Budget

- a. The Police Department is looking to use funds from 2025 to pay for the 2026 taser contract and for new cameras and cloud system for them. This would remove \$26,000 from the 2026 budget. It will be presented at the BoS meeting tonight. Health insurance went up 6.4% and the police department employees are responsible for 15% of their health insurance. The Police Department’s budget went up 6.8% with COLA and
